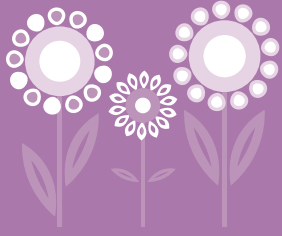

REMINDERS

PREPARATION

- Use 12.5-gallon trash bags.
- Limit of 2 bags of trash per night
- If you have more than one bag, place the second on top of the can, NOT on the floor.
- Please break down all boxes.
- When the bag gets full, TIE IT, and set the can outside your front door on **pickup nights** from **6–8PM.**

COLLECTION

- Trash Fairies start their collection at 8PM.
- Collection days are **Sunday–Thursday.**
- NO collection on Friday or Saturday night
- NO oversized/overweight items, liquid, hazardous waste, or loose trash
- Do NOT put trash bags on the floor.

NEXT MORNING

- Bring your empty can inside by 9AM the next day.

TRASH CHUTE

- Ensure that you are placing your bags in the chutes and NOT on the floor in the trash room. You will be charged a \$50 removal fee if you leave trash on the floor.
- Do NOT put boxes in the trash chute: break them down and place them outside of the trash room on the 1st floor.

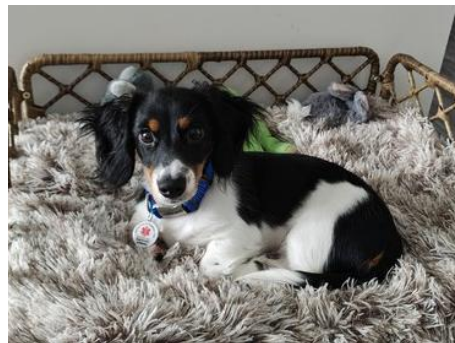

Wild World: Bumblebee

If you see a plump, fuzzy bee flying around some flowers, you're likely looking at a bumblebee. By beating their wings more than 130 times per second, these insects create their trademark buzzing noise, which shakes pollen loose from flowers and onto nearby blossoms. This unique action is called buzz pollination, which many plants rely on to produce fruit, including tomatoes, eggplants and cranberries. Bumblebees are social like honeybees, but their colonies are much smaller and usually located underground. A bumblebee has two large eyes on the front of its head and three smaller eyes on top, useful when seeking out its favorite colors of flowers, blue and purple.

Inside a Thunderstorm

Some find thunderstorms soothing, while others think they're scary. Around 100,000 storms take place in the U.S. every year, mostly in the spring and summer. Storms often happen on hot, humid days, as warm air rises and collides with cold air, creating tension in the atmosphere. Ice particles inside of clouds swirl and crash together, resulting in static electricity that's released in the form of lightning. And did you know that thunder is simply the noise that lightning makes? We just see lightning first since light travels faster than sound.

Getting Spicy With Salsa

Celebrating Cinco de Mayo this month means many people will be serving up some salsa. Did you know that the word “salsa” actually means “sauce” in Spanish? Take your taste buds on a spin and get ready to dip into these different salsa varieties.

Salsa roja. The classic red salsa is made with tomatoes, chili peppers, onions, garlic and cilantro. Blended and cooked, this salsa is perfect for dipping chips or topping tacos and enchiladas.

Salsa verde. Salsa verde is a green, tomatillo-based salsa. The tomatillo is the star of salsa verde, often lending the condiment a slightly tarter flavor than its red counterpart. Salsa verde goes great with grilled meats.

Pico de gallo. Also known as salsa fresca, pico de gallo is fresh salsa that is served uncooked. Chopped tomatoes, jalapenos, onions, cilantro and lime make salsa fresca the ultimate versatile topping for many dishes. For a fancy twist, other fresh ingredients can be substituted for tomatoes, such as cucumber or pineapple to create a different flavor combination.

Avocado salsa. Avocado salsa is almost on its way to becoming guacamole but instead of blending the avocados, they're left in chunks and mingled with tomatoes, onions, cilantro and lime. Avocado salsa is a creamy alternative that traditionally isn't known for heat.

Whether you choose a mild or fiery option, salsa is more than a condiment. It's a celebration of bold, vibrant flavors!
